Publicly, he is a Visiting Orthopaedic Specialist at the Royal Adelaide Hospital, where he performs upper limb, sports injury and trauma surgery, and the Repatriation General Hospital, where he performs joint replacement surgery.

After graduating from Flinders University in 1997, Dr Sood obtained Fellowship of the Royal Australasian College of Surgeons (Orthopaedic Surgery) in 2008. He then undertook specialist post-fellowship training in upper limb surgery with the highly respected Dr Mark Ross in Brisbane, before visiting a number of recognised centres of orthopaedic excellence in the UK, France, Switzerland and Italy. His research has won awards both locally and nationally.
